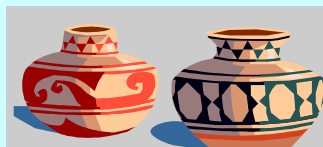

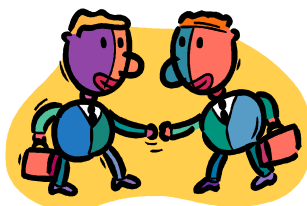

Sacramento Valley Chapter of the California Native Plant Society

Monthly meeting and presentation

Guest speaker: Cassandra Nguyen Musto will speak of how the Department of Water Resources (DWR) and its partners have managed the Central Valley levee system to improve flood management while allowing vegetation to remain on the levees for habitat and other purposes. A proposed U.S. Army Corps of Engineers national-level vegetation removal policy, if implemented, may have devastating consequences for the Central Valley's environment, threatening steelhead, salmon and other endangered species. Learn about the concerns of DWR and other state, local and federal agencies and DWR's proposed solution to the Corps' policy.

Ms. Musto is an Associate Landscape Architect with the Department of Water Resources' Levee Repair Branch.
